Just a congregational reminder about departing pastors: When a Pastor leaves a congregation, they are expected to sign an agreement with Synod to refrain from official business with their previous congregation (including attending members, nonmembers, and their families). They are required, whether they sign it or not, to refrain from presiding over funerals, weddings, etc. at any location out of respect for the new pastor and allow the new pastor to develop a relationship with the congregation. Planning Council would like to ask our congregation to respect the Synod guidelines and refer questions or concerns to Planning Council or Pastor Bonnie.




