Also, you are cordially invited to Pastor Bonnie's Service of Ordination here at Grace on Saturday, July 31 at 2:00 pm.




Our Grace Youth Mission Trip team will be sharing their witness and work experiences from their recent Mission Trip to Niagara Falls, NY.

Dear Friends,

This Sunday, July 25, is my final Sunday at Grace. I wish to thank you for the opportunity to share the ministry of the Gospel of Jesus Christ these last ten months. It has been a very strange interim for me. Though I was with you ten months, three of those I was in Texas. Half of the time the church was closed and all activities were online. Even when the church was open activities were significantly curtailed. Over those ten months, all but six weeks we were masked and observing social distancing.

Still it was my honor and privilege to walk with you on this strange journey. I appreciate the opportunity to journey with you in your walk of faith.

Here is my final covenant with you.


