Let's rally our spirits in our generosity and hospitality, joyfully sharing what we have in our Grace offerings and gifts, welcoming others with open, caring, hearts!


I am grateful to be here at Grace for a third year as your pastor! Every meeting and group I work with at Grace without exception, genuinely enjoys what they do. And it shows!


If you would like to provide altar flowers in memory or in honor of loved ones, please either sign up on the list in the Narthex or call the church office at 330-343-6915.
