Dear Friends in Christ,

As we approach and celebrate Rally Day on Aug.18th, I want to talk about what Rally Day is really all about for us. First let us begin with what Jesus commands us to do:

Mark 12:29-31: Jesus answered, "The first is, 'Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one; you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.' The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

Jesus is quoting from the "Shema" which is **Deuteronomy 6:4-7:** Hear, O Israel: The LORD is our God, the LORD alone. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise.

We here at Grace are committed to keeping these commands in our hearts, teaching them and talking about them in our Sunday Schools, worship services, boards, groups, homes, work, vacations, all day, every day.

Rally Day is when we recommit ourselves to a new church year of doing what Jesus commands us do. Let us all make it a priority to come to church on Rally Day and to the meal and program that follows to reset our hearts, minds, bodies and souls to follow what Jesus commands us to do.

And finally, by our baptisms, we have the Holy Spirit to give us the wisdom and power we need to follow Jesus' commands, and the peace, joy, hope, and love that comes with doing it. Let us rally together as one body in Christ at Grace Lutheran Church, Dover!

Congregational Survey August 2024

Planning Council agreed July 16th that we will return to two services (8 and 10:30) for now. The change to one service was originally intended for the slower summer months with the plan to return to the regular (2) services at the end of summer when Sunday school restarts.
