Worship Schedule Sunday: 8 AM and 10:30 AM Sunday Church School for all ages: 9:15 AM

November 29 is the First Sunday in Advent. As the world begins to celebrate Christmas on Thanksgiving weekend (did it start on Halloween this year?), the Church begins its celebration of Advent. Advent means "coming." It is the season which we prepare our hearts for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

One of the themes of Advent is "waiting." God's people waited for centuries for the coming of its savior. After the conquering of country Judah and its Holy City of Jerusalem in 587 B.C., the prophets started speaking of a messiah or savior whom God would send to his people. In the words of Isaiah, the savior would be "named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." Isaiah 9:7

God's people waited, and they waited, and they waited. They waited through those horrible years of the Exile. They waited through the exiles disappointing return after the Exile. They waited through all those centuries of foreign occupation. God's people waited.

Finally after over 500 years the promise was fulfilled and Jesus was born! On that night the angels sang and the stars shone bright.

And now we are waiting again. We await Jesus' final return when all the promises will be fulfilled. We await the day when the Kingdom will come in its entirety and all God's people will be made new! Again, we have been waiting a long time. It is close to two thousand years since those promises was made, but we know that our God fulfills all His promises. Just as Jesus finally came the first time after that long time of waiting, so shall he return!

This will be our second time we will winter in Texas. Last year we returned on March 25. The very next Sunday the church I was serving decided cancel in-person services. Very soon we were up doing services on Zoom. All other in-person activities at church were canceled. If we could not do it on Zoom then it did not happen. Midsummer we started doing in-person services in the church parking lot. It was good to be able to see at least some of us in person. All other in-person activities were canceled. A little bit later we were able to upgrade our online service to Facebook Live. I am told since I left they very briefly moved their service inside, but the county going red brought that to a halt.

When I came here in mid-October attendance was significantly down to the virus. (It is everywhere). Because of masks I only got to see people from the eyes on up. Chatting after church discouraged. Most of the church activities had been canceled. Once the county went red even those few activities were canceled. We are back to the all too familiar online services and programming.

I am tired of all this. Nothing has been right since that last Sunday in March. I am tired of scaled back ministry. I am tired of staying at home. I am tired of not being able to go out or see family. I am tired of loved ones getting sick. I am tired of being afraid. I am tired of waiting for things to go back to normal.

Perhaps this is why Advent is so important this year. Advent tells us God is in control. God is not absent when we go through time of trial. Advent tells us that there will be an end to this scourge. Just as Advent ended with the miracle of the birth of a special child, our time of trial will end with a miracle of modern science.

Our time of waiting will end.

But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope: The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases, his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "therefore I will hope in him." The LORD is good to those who wait for him, to the soul that seeks him. It is good that one should wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD. Lamentation 3:21-26

GROCERY BAG MINISTRY

Thanks to all who have volunteered to be packers for the Grocery Bag Ministry this year.

Grocery bag distribution is temporarily suspended. We expect when it resumes, the need will be great. We are still accepting food and monetary donations.
