**Olivia Wellman**, daughter of Ted & Tracia Wellman of Dover, attends Ohio University and studies speech-language pathology.



Remember the work of the church continues year round even if you cannot attend worship. Please consider a regular weekly or monthly contribution to the church year round so the important work at Grace continues!






