According to the YMBALI tee shirt the best clue that one actually might be a Lutheran is that "You are watching Star Wars and when you hear someone say, "The Force be with you," you reply, "And also with you!" The next best clue is that when you sing the hymn, "Stand Up, Stand Up for Jesus" you secretly wish that you could sit down. Another clue is that you have an irresistible urge to sit in the back of any room, especially a church.




