### LEADERS NEEDED

There is a group called a “nominating committee” that is working on putting together a slate of people to be potential board members and chairpersons for Grace Lutheran Church. Some of you who are reading this newsletter may have already been approached about being one of the nominees for some position of leadership. I hope that when you are asked you will think, and pray before answering “yes” or “no”. In addition, I hope that you will keep in mind that this particular year is a crucial one for our congregation and the lay leadership in the congregation.

This year we will be calling a new pastor. The call committee has already begun the process of interviewing possible pastors to be called to provide pastoral leadership. But keep in mind, there is NO pastor who has been given every gift that is needed to carry out the mission and ministries God is challenging us as a congregation to carry out in the name of Jesus. Every pastor has been given by God a unique set of gifts and abilities. The same holds true for all the baptized who make up the body of Christ, and our particular part of the one body of Christ called Grace Lutheran Church. And all of the gifts are needed!

There are two challenges for the Call Committee, Nominating Committee, Planning Council as well as the entire congregation this year: The first is discerning the mission and ministries that God is calling us to carry out, and having as much clarity and focus on mission and ministries as possible. The second is discerning what kinds of gifts and abilities are needed by BOTH pastor and lay leaders to carry out the mission and ministries.

But that is really only the beginning. The next challenge is for all of us, interim pastor, new pastor, old and new lay leaders, as well as every member of the congregation, to focus on what needs to be done, and who is best equipped to do what in order to carry out the mission and implement the ministries.

Keep the nominating committee, call committee, and all the current leaders of the congregation in your prayers. Also give prayerful consideration to how, when and where God would have you make use of your gifts in the months and years ahead.

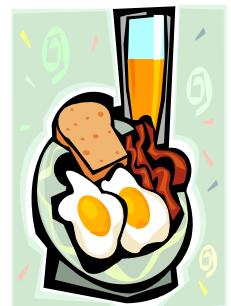

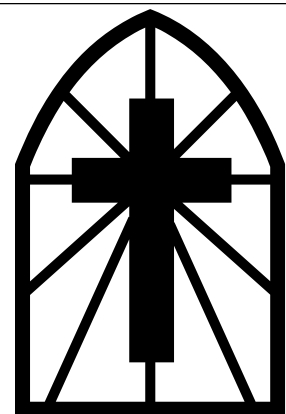
## FOCUS ON THE CROSS

**HEALTH KITS AND LAYETTES**

Two of our Lutheran World Relief Projects are making Health Kits and School Kits. These kits provide much needed supplies to many people around the world. Items that go into each kit are:

**Health Kits**

- 1 hand towel (dark color)
- 1 wash cloth (dark color), 1 bath size bar of soap
- 1 adult size toothbrush, 1 nail clipper with file
- 1 wide tooth comb, 6 band-aids

**School Kits**

- Padded or spinal notebooks of ruled paper approx. 8 1/2" X 11" totaling 150-200 sheets; do not include loose leaf paper
- 1 blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- 1 30-centimeter ruler, or ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- 1 pencil sharpener, 1 eraser approx. 2 1/2 " long
- 6 new, unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- 12 sheets of construction paper in assorted colors
- 1 box of 16 or 24 crayons

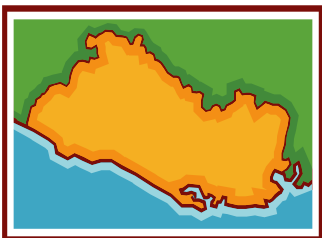
If you are unable to deliver your portion of the meal, please contact someone else who has signed up to deliver food.
