Dear Friends in Christ,

Have I told you how much I love and am grateful for our church? The Sunday immediately after the devastating Hurricane Helene hit, some of you asked how they could donate money to help those tragically affected. I was grateful for the Lutheran Disaster Hurricane Response donation link from the ELCA we posted on our Grace Lutheran Facebook page. Some of you used that and some wrote checks to the church with Lutheran Disaster Hurricane Response in the memo.

The First Moravian Church graciously invited Cody Jerles to take part in an adult mission trip to North Carolina to do hands on clean up and rebuilding, and he in turn invited skilled, willing, and able adults here to represent Grace Lutheran with him this month and some of you are going!

Student Council students in a local school wanted to have a supplies drive for those in North Carolina and Cody Jerles, their advisor, asked me if I had heard of any ways they could do this. Our adult mission trip will be taking a truck and a trailer with these supplies to deliver them. You all may also donate water, canned goods and personal care items and bring them to the church office by Wed. November 6.

As I was returning from our vacation and delayed at the Charlotte airport, I spoke to an interesting 19 year old young man from Georgia who was in the process of doing lineman work in the devastated area. This led to a conversation about our church helping in the hurricane response and my being a pastor that astounded him. So much so that he face-timed his family and introduced me to them.

Finally, I got back to the office and gratefully found that our endowment committee had granted funds toward the ELCA hurricane relief response.

Helping those in need to share God's love is what Christ's church's mission is all about and I'm so grateful that Grace Lutheran Church lives it out so authentically.



Currently, we are in the process of having the solo division of the organ fixed and returned to a previous condition. We are also planning on having a few additions made. We will have the solo division returning with an 8 ft Festival trumpet, and 8 ft harmonic flute, a 4-ft orchestral flute, and 8 ft solo string, and an 8 ft oboe.

Mutation stops will be added to the swell which will consist of a Nazard of 2 and 2/3 flute and a Tierce of 1 and 3/5 flute. Softer flutes in the pedal division will be added. Some of this plan is to use the pipes that are there but are not functioning at this time. We will also be adding chimes to the organ. We have a stop on the organ for this, but no chimes.

These changes will add to the organ's capabilities and help to enhance our worship services. At the present time, we are applying for Grants to help us fund this project. More details to follow. Page 4 THE MESSENGER


Grocery size paper bags are also needed.




