Dear Friends in Christ,

This is what I get to look at every time I preside at communion! Wow! It is called the Te Deum window which was installed in 1960 along with our custom Swiss made pipe organ in our gallery. I have been trying to understand this beautiful work in its entirety. Does anyone know the name of the designer or have information about its meaning from its installation?

These questions have been stuck in my head since Pastor Steve Patrick asked me what I thought about the window's images (especially on the lower left above what appears to be a broken arrow and laid down sword). He also said that the window reflects on the inside of the communion chalice when the light shines a certain way. If you see me smiling during communion when I look up, raise my hands and cross myself when you sing, "Hosanna. Hosanna. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord", you know what I'm looking at!

I will let you all know the meaning of this striking stained-glass window as soon as I find out. I am constantly being reminded of how beautiful our church is in every way, not just in our sanctuary but in our people who shine Christ's light so brightly.

Our Grace knotters are in need of flat bed sheets (any size) to make quilts.




