Dear Friends in Christ,

When the Holy Spirit moves, it is a powerful thing! There is a gentleman in our greater community who has come to our office before in genuine need. One time he had a house fire and he smelled like the kind of smoke I remember when my kitchen stove caught fire and ashes and soot were everywhere. He needed cleaning supplies and we helped him with those through my pastor's discretionary fund. Another time, he needed groceries to make it through the week and our Food Pantry gave him a grocery bag of food. Last week, he desperately needed back-to-school clothing for his two grandsons who live with him and his wife since school was starting. I thought to myself that this will be a lot more than I have in my pastor's discretionary fund. So, after trying to get these boys help from Dress A Child and finding that they are delayed, I did something I haven't done yet at Grace – I asked Lisa to post an urgent notice on our Facebook page to help them.

Immediately responses started coming in and the post was shared 34 times during the week. Sole Purpose donated vouchers for new shoes from Encore at New Town Mall! One woman who had previously bought clothing that were still in the bag with the tags on in the sizes the boys needed had just been wondering what to do with them when she saw our post. She said it was clear that God was speaking to her. She was thrilled to be able to help these boys! Another went shopping and brought in some new clothes that are returnable if needed. Some donated gently used clothing and shoes their boys had outgrown.

The gentleman cried and thanked our church when he received the clothing. I gave him a blessing prayer for his family and the school year. The boys are all set for their school year thanks to your hearts and generosity for those in need that spread out far to our greater community! Ultimately, the gospel of Jesus Christ was shared 34 times on our church's Facebook page reaching many. This week I also found new resources from a few of you to try when people need clothing. Thank you, Grace Lutheran Church, for being "the church" to our greater community!


