Our Liturgical Worship

There are many ways to worship. Our tradition at Grace is to use what we call "liturgy". Liturgical worship has been a central component of Christian practice for centuries, shaping the communal and spiritual life of believers. The term "liturgy" refers to the structured form of worship that typically includes prayers, readings, hymns, sacraments, and rituals. While Christian worship can take many forms, liturgical worship is distinct for its emphasis on tradition, order, and communal participation.

Liturgical worship promotes a sense of community and unity within the church. The structured order of service means that everyone participates together, reciting prayers and responses as one body. This shared experience fosters a spirit of togetherness and helps build relationships among church members.

If a congregation spends time learning liturgy well (as we are right now) the result is voices raised in praise and joy. That joy is contagious as others can feel it.

Liturgical worship is designed to embody and communicate the core truths of Christianity. Through rituals such as baptism and communion, believers physically enact the gospel message. The liturgy's structure ensures that key aspects of the faith—such as repentance, forgiveness, thanksgiving, and praise—are consistently emphasized.

Our prayer is that each Sunday when a person attends worship, they will have a genuine encounter with the living God who created them, redeemed them and sustains them. With that kind of touch from God we go froth in joy rejoicing in the power of the Holy Spirit.

A Few Changes

A pastor walks into a church council meeting and asks, "How many Lutherans does it take to change a light bulb?" The answer.....CHANGE?

Here are few changes with explanations of why they were instituted.

- 1 The tradition of coming forward to the rail to receive Holy Communion on the first Sunday of the month is discontinued as of October. The main reason for this is the risk of falling due to the fact there are stairs up and stairs down; there are not always enough ushers to stand by those who might need help. While many of us enjoy kneeling at the rail the greater concern for safety outweighs that. This change has been the result of discussions and prayerful consideration since June.
- 2 Communion Assistants are now referred to as Worship Assistants because they do more than assist at communion. Pastor Phil will be inviting more individuals to step forward for some training on reading and assisting at the altar.
- 3 Worship Assistants are no longer wearing a Deacon stole. The term Deacon refers to one who is ordained in the ELCA to the *Ministry of Word and Service*. (Pastors are ordained to the *Ministry of Word and Sacrament*.)

"Showing Jesus" to Our Harbor House Neighbors


